Thanksgiving

- * The Pilgrim Fathers, who founded the Thanksgiving tradition, arrived in America in September 1620.
- It was a very difficult journey for them.
- * They sailed from Plymouth, England across the Atlantic Ocean, on a ship called the Mayflower, to Cape Cod in North America.
- They left England because of religion, and because they wanted land for their families.

- They wanted to start a new life and practise their religion in freedom.
- * The Pilgrims sailed for 66 dangerous days.
- When they arrived they called their new home New England.
- However, they were not the first people to live there.
- * The Indians or Native Americans were there first.

- * The first winter was very severe for them.
- * From the 110 Pilgrims who left England and the crew who left England, less than 50 people survived.
- Many Pilgrims died because the winter was very cold and they had only little food.
- * In the spring, Native inhabitants decided to help them showing them how to grow corn.

- * The two Native Inhabitans, who spoke English
 - Squanto and Samoset, also showed them plants to treat the illnesses.
- They also showed them how to hunt for food and how to build better houses.
- In the autumn 1621 they celebrated the first successful harvest.

- * To thank the Native Americans, the Pilgrims invited them to a special dinner to celebrate the harvest, their new home, and their friendship.
- * This special dinner was the first Thanksgiving.
- The first Thansgiving dinner lasted fot three days.

- Most American families still have a Thanksgiving dinner.


THANKSGIVING DINNER
